









## STP Overview

STP is a free, self-paced, online program that provides construction workers with the skills and knowledge needed to advance their careers. The program is designed for workers who are currently employed in the construction industry and are looking for ways to improve their skills and advance their careers.

STP is a 6-month program that consists of 120 hours of instruction. The program is divided into three phases: Phase 1 (30 hours), Phase 2 (30 hours), and Phase 3 (60 hours). Each phase focuses on different areas of construction, such as safety, quality control, and project management.

## STP Participants

Over 150,000 construction workers have completed the STP program since its inception. The program has been successful in providing workers with the skills and knowledge they need to advance their careers and improve their quality of life.

### Program Completion Certificate

Upon successful completion of the STP program, participants will receive a Program Completion Certificate. This certificate is recognized by the American Council on Education (ACEA) and is equivalent to 1-6 college credit.
